



Bronchiectasis

Bronchiectasis is a chronic obstructive lung disease characterized by chronic cough with sputum production. There is dilatation of the bronchi with resultant difficulty clearing secretions. The productive cough is due to infections of the airways. Rarely localized cases have been cured by surgery. Others may be controlled by judicious use of antibiotics and positioning techniques to help clear the airways of secretions. Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) develops as a result of the ongoing inflammation and infection.

Mild	None—except for occasional throat clearing and respiratory infection	None	60-80%	B
Moderate	Airway obstruction on moderate exertion such as climbing two flights of stairs	Inhaler	50-60%	D
Severe	Shortness of breath with activity such as dressing, walking one block	Steroids, multiple medications	40-50%	G
Extreme	Disabled, shortness of breath at rest or minimal activity	Home oxygen	<40%	Decline
